Purpose of Form

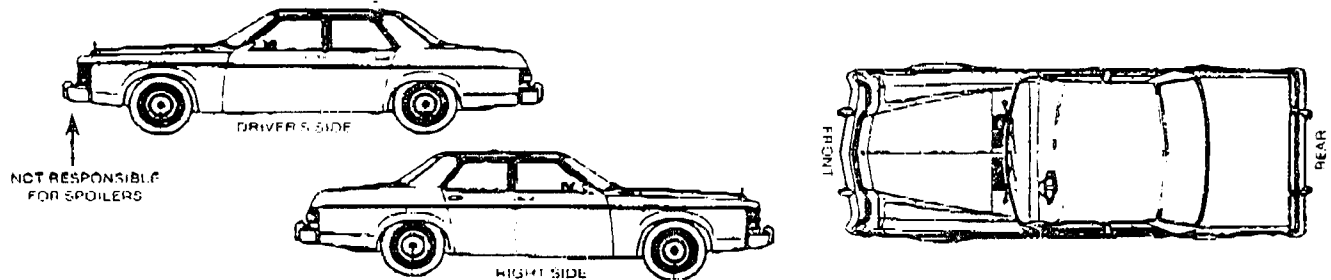

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Owner shall designate a person to act as his agent at the point of pickup and/or delivery, if for any reason they are unavailable.
2. By owner's signature or his/her agent's signature. Kiwi's Karriers and driver or agents, jointly and separately are authorized to operate and transport the vehicle(s) from the point of origin specified on the reverse side to the point of departure and to the specified final destination via any mode.
3. If the driver is delayed at point of pickup or delivery, through no fault of the carrier, or through any act, or failure to act, of owner, consignee or their agents, contrary to the provisions of the agreement, a late charge shall be assessed at the rate of \$15.00 per hour, subject to a maximum of \$120.00 for any 24 hour period. Such charges shall be in addition to all other charges provided herein. All fees not paid when the order is tendered for shipment will be added onto the amount to be paid on delivery.
4. All monies must be in the form of a money order, cashier's check, or in the case of delivery, cash may also be presented. Personal checks will not be accepted and orders will not be processed and cars subject to storage fees if they are at any point presented for payment.
5. The carrier does not agree to transport shipments on any particular truck or by any particular driver, or in time for any particular market and will not be responsible for loss or damage occasioned by unavoidable delay. There are absolutely no guarantees made, expressed or implied, regarding pickup and/or delivery times or dates. Carrier will not be held responsible for any non-use of the vehicle charges including, but not limited to car rentals, interest, floor planning, or any other charges due to delay or damage.
6. Personal belongings left in the vehicle are not insured and are shipped at the owner's risk.
7. The following items are not to be in the vehicle at time of shipment:
guns, explosives, ammunition, inflammable products, narcotics, negotiable and legal papers, alcoholic beverages, jewelry, furs, money, other articles of unusual value, pets, live plants, or contraband.
8. All non-operational vehicles tendered for transportation will be charged an additional \$100.00. If a vehicle is rendered for shipment and later becomes non-operations, the \$100.00 fee will be added onto the amount to be collected, as well as any other charges necessary to accomplish delivery. Owner may be required to pick up vehicle at a terminal facility if additional fees are due upon delivery.
9. Nothing in this agreement shall be construed as making it binding on Carrier to pick up and/or deliver at locations from or to which it is impractical to operate Carrier's equipment on account of conditions of highways, streets, or other passageways or inadequate loading or unloading facilities.
10. Carrier will not knowingly transport any uninsured vehicle. If vehicle is not insured, and owner fails to notify Carrier of such, Carrier will not be held responsible for any claim against owner or itself and owner will be sued for any damages which may occur.
11. If vehicle is vandalized either during shipment or while awaiting shipment, Carrier will not be held responsible; owner will have to submit a claim to his own insurance or absorb the loss if there is no insurance.
12. If there is any claim problem upon delivery, the balance due must be paid before a claim can commence. All damages must be properly noted in the presence of the driver. Signing of the Bill Of Lading at destination, without immediate notation of alleged damage, shall be evidence of satisfactory deliver of vehicle. Regardless of weather or time of day, vehicle examination is responsibility of receiver.
13. No claims shall be accepted unless noted upon delivery of vehicle in the presence of the Driver. All claims subject to a \$250.00 deductible. Claims resulting therefore must be in writing to Kiwi's Karriers providing photographs with actual proof of damage. Claims must be made within 15 days.

This agreement supersedes all prior written and/or oral agreements between Kiwi's Karriers and the owner and may not be changed except when in writing by an officer of the company.

Should shipper commence legal action against Kiwi's Karriers prevail, then Kiwi's Karriers will be entitled to reimbursement for all its attorney fees and court costs.
